A Lenten Devotion



From the Music Director

An Old Irish Blessing (May the road rise up to meet you...)

Ancient Celtic literature frequently used images of nature to speak of how God interacts with us. This blessing, whose author and date are unknown, alludes to three images from nature – wind, sun, and rain – as pictures of God's care and provision. The "wind" can be likened to the Spirit of God, who comes as a "mighty wind" at Pentecost. The sun's warmth reminds us "of the tender mercy of our God by which the daybreak from on high will visit us" (Luke 1:78), while the soft falling rain speaks of God's provision and sustenance. Finally, it reminds us we are held safe in God's loving hands as we travel on our journey through life. A very literal translation of the first line is actually "may your road be successful" while a more idiomatic translation would be "may your journey [through life] succeed."

In Celtic times, traveling poets would offer blessing services to clans as they crossed throughout the country.



This tradition of the Irish blessing continued into Christian times, so St. Kevin would have certainly offered these kinds of blessings. And may we continue to do so in this parish that bears his name! Happy St. Patrick's Day!



St. Kevin Faith Formation Registration for September 2024

The St. Kevin Office of Religious Education provides a comprehensive faith formation program for children in grades 1-8 that do not attend a Catholic School.

Registration for September, 2024 Religious Education classes is ongoing thru September. Families who are already in our program will receive notification via email. Any families new to the program can visit our parish website for the on-line registration form at: <u>https://stkevinflushing.org/faith-formation/registration</u>. All new children or families please include in your email your child's baptismal certificate plus vaccination record, which are needed for registration. Our classes will be as follows:

Classes will be remote two Sunday's a month and in school two Sunday's. Sunday Mass attendance is required for all families in our program. Families are asked to attend the 9:00 AM mass with their children. Then the children will go to the school for instruction from 10:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Parents are invited to the Parish Hall for an Adult session while your children are in class. Remote classes will be scheduled on Sunday morning. If you are not able the 9:00 AM Mass, please choose another mass to fulfill your Sunday Obligation.
